# Recalculating Charting a Different Course in a Perpetually Offended Nation

God blesses those who work for peace, for they will be called the children of God. Matthew 5:9 (NLT)

If I want to recalculate, choosing <u>offense</u> and choosing <u>peace</u> are within my power.

Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth. **Matthew 5:5 (NIV)** 

- Meekness is NOT: Weakness
- Meekness IS: Strength under control

If I Am Truly a Christ-Follower, I'm in the Driver's Seat of My Own Reactions:

1. When someone disappoints me.

<u>Accept</u> him whose faith is weak, <u>without passing judgment</u> on disputable matters. **Romans 14:1 (NIV)** 

I can choose to be gentle, not judgmental.

Accept one another, then, <u>just as Christ accepted you</u>, in order to <u>bring praise to God</u>. **Romans 15:7 (NIV)** 

As a follower of Jesus, I can <u>accept and love</u> someone without <u>approving</u> of their lifestyle choices.

2. When someone disagrees with me.

"You never fight a battle where winning doesn't make any difference. Don't get into an argument over something that doesn't matter anyway." - Gen. George S. Patton

### I can choose to be tender, without surrender.

A gentle answer deflects anger, but harsh words make tempers flare. ...the mouth of a fool belches out foolishness. **Proverbs 15:1-2 (NLT)** 

"We should be too big to take offense, and too noble to give it." - Abraham Lincoln

## I can disagree, without being disagreeable.

Again I say, don't get involved in foolish, ignorant arguments that only start fights. A servant of the Lord must not quarrel but must be kind to everyone... patient with difficult people. Gently instruct those who oppose the truth. Perhaps God will change those people's hearts, and they will learn the truth. 2 Timothy 2:23-25 (NLT)

My dear brothers, take note of this: <u>Everyone</u> should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry... **James 1:19 (NIV)** 

#### 3. When someone hurts me.

God did not give us a spirit that makes us afraid but a spirit of <u>power</u> and <u>love</u> and <u>self-control</u>. **2 Timothy 1:7 (NCV)**
