<sup>21</sup> I have discovered this principle of life—that when I want to do what is right, I inevitably do what is wrong. <sup>22</sup> I **love God's law** with all my heart. <sup>23</sup> **But** there is another power within me that is at war with my mind. This power makes me a slave to the sin that is still within me.

## <sup>24</sup> Oh, what a miserable person I am! Who will free me from this life that is dominated by sin and death? <sup>25</sup> Thank God! The answer is in Jesus Christ our Lord. Romans 7:15-25 (NLT)
