“Contentment”

Contentment = *happy enough with what one has or is; not desiring something more or different; satisfied.*

¹² *I know what it is to be in need, and I know what it is to have plenty. I have learned the secret of being content in any and every situation, whether well fed or hungry, whether living in plenty or in want.* ¹³ *I can do all this through him who gives me strength.*

Philippians 4:12-13 (NIV)

1. Contentment is a **LEARNED** attitude.

¹² *I know what it is to be **in need**, and I know what it is to **have plenty**. I have **learned** the **secret** of being content...*

Philippians 4:12a-12b (NIV)

2. Contentment isn't gained through **PROSPERITY** - nor lost through **POVERTY**.

¹² *...whether **well fed or hungry**, whether living **in plenty or want**.* **Philippians 4:12c (NIV)**

3. True contentment is found **THROUGH CHRIST'S POWER**.

¹³ *I can do all this **through Him** who gives me strength.*

Philippians 4:13 (NIV)

¹² *For the word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the **thoughts and attitudes of the heart**.* **Hebrews 4:12 (NIV)**
