⁷ But to each one of us grace has been given as Christ apportioned it. ¹¹ It was He who gave some to be **apostles**, some to be **prophets**, some to be **evangelists**, and some to be **pastors** and **teachers**, **Ephesians 4:7; 11 (NIV)**

¹² to prepare God's people for works of service, **so that** (the reason for it) the body of Christ may be built up ¹³ **until we all** (“until” implies ongoing till the goal is met, and the goal is “all”) reach **unity in the faith** and in the knowledge of the

Son of God and become mature, **attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.** Ephesians 4:12-13 (NIV)

¹⁴ Then we will no **longer be infants**, (the maturity of the believer in the church) tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of men in their deceitful scheming. ¹⁵ Instead, **speaking the truth in love**, (the impact in our communities, the way the church should be) we will in all things **grow up** into him who is (here comes the visual aid) **the Head**, that is, Christ. ¹⁶ From him the **whole body**, joined and held together by **every supporting ligament**, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work. **Ephesians 4:14-16 (NIV)**
