¹ *On the third day a wedding took place at Cana in Galilee. Jesus’ mother was there, ² and **Jesus and his disciples had also been invited to the wedding.** John 2:1-2 (NIV)*

³ *When the wine was gone, Jesus’ mother said to him, **“They have no more wine.”** John 2:3 (NIV)*

Their biggest concern was for their guests.

⁴ *“Woman, why do you involve me?” Jesus replied. **“My hour has not yet come.”** John 2:4 (NIV)*

Jesus stops and does something that He is extremely overqualified for.

⁵ *His mother said to the servants, **“Do whatever he tells you.”** John 2:5 (NIV)*

When Jesus tells you to do something – you just do it.

⁶ *Nearby stood six stone water jars, the kind used by the Jews for ceremonial washing, each holding from twenty to thirty gallons. ⁷ Jesus said to the servants, **“Fill the jars with water”**; so they filled them to the brim. John 2:6-7 (NIV)*

Jesus turns our ordinary service into the extraordinary!

⁸ *Then he told them, “Now draw some out and take it to the master of the banquet.” They did so, ⁹ and the master of the banquet tasted the water that had been turned into wine. He did not realize where it had come from, **though the servants who had drawn the water knew.** Then he called the bridegroom aside ¹⁰ and said, “Everyone brings out the choice wine first and then the cheaper wine after the guests have had too much to drink; but you have saved the best till now.” John 2:8-10 (NIV)*
