## JUDGE THE BELIEVIN' - NOT THE HEATHEN!

JUDGING = to make a follower of Christ feel challenged yet loved, convicted yet cared for, while being directed toward strong truth with much grace.

JUDGMENTAL = to point out something sinful in someone's life, (even those who don't know God), while making them feel put down, excluded and marginalized.
