HOW CHANGE HAPPENS "Enemies of Change"

Change ALWAYS encounters opposition.

¹ Sanballat was **very angry** when he learned that we were rebuilding the wall. He flew into a **rage** and **mocked** the Jews, ² saying **in front of his friends and the Samarian army officers**, "What does this bunch of **poor**, **feeble** Jews think they're doing? Do they think they can build the wall **in a single day** by just offering a few sacrifices? Do they actually **think** they can make something of stones from a rubbish heap—and charred ones at that?" ³ Tobiah the Ammonite, who was standing beside him, remarked, "That stone wall would collapse if **even a fox** walked along the top of it!" **Nehemiah 4:1-3 (NLT)**

ANGER - PUBLIC RIDICULE - MOCKERY - SARCASM -LAUGHTER

⁴ Then I prayed, "**Hear us, our God,** for we are being mocked. May their scoffing fall back on their own heads, and may they themselves become captives in a foreign land! ⁵ Do not ignore their guilt. Do not blot out their sins, for they have provoked you to anger here in front of the builders." **Nehemiah 4:4-5 (NLT)**

HEART BURN KNEES BENT INSIDE OUT

⁶ At last the wall was completed to **half its height** around the entire city, for the people had worked with enthusiasm. **Nehemiah 4:6 (NLT)**

⁷ But when Sanballat and Tobiah and the Arabs,

Ammonites, and Ashdodites heard that the work was going ahead and that the gaps in the wall of Jerusalem were being repaired, they were furious. ⁸ They all made plans to come and fight against Jerusalem and throw us into confusion. Nehemiah 4:7-8 (NLT)

⁹ But we prayed to our God and guarded the city day and night to protect ourselves. Nehemiah 4:9 (NLT)

There is always GOD'S PART and OUR PART

¹⁰ Then the people of Judah began to complain, "The **workers are getting tired**, and there is **so much rubble** to be moved. We **will never** be able to build the wall by ourselves." **Nehemiah 4:10 (NLT)**

¹¹ Meanwhile, our enemies were saying, "Before they know what's happening, we will **swoop down on them and kill them and end their work**." ¹² The Jews who lived near the enemy came and told us again and again, "They will come from all directions and attack us!" **Nehemiah 4:11-12 (NLT)**

¹³ So I placed armed guards behind the lowest parts of the wall in the exposed areas. I stationed the people to stand guard **by families, armed with swords, spears, and bows**. ¹⁴ Then as I looked over the situation, I called together the nobles and the rest of the people and said to them, **"Don't be afraid of the enemy! Remember the Lord, who is great and glorious, and fight for your brothers, your sons, your daughters, your wives, and your homes!" Nehemiah 4:13-14 (NLT)**

¹⁵ When **our enemies heard** that we knew of their plans and that God had frustrated them, we all **returned to our work** on the wall. ¹⁶ But from then on, **only half my men worked** while the **other half stood guard with spears**, shields, bows, and coats of mail. The leaders stationed themselves behind the people of Judah ¹⁷ who were building the wall. The laborers carried on their work **with one hand supporting their load and one hand holding a weapon**. ¹⁸ All the builders had a sword belted to their side. The trumpeter stayed with me to sound the alarm. **Nehemiah 4:15-18 (NLT)**

¹⁹ Then I explained to the nobles and officials and all the people, "The work is very spread out, and we are **widely separated from each other** along the wall. ²⁰ When you hear

the blast of the trumpet, **rush to wherever it is sounding**. **Then our God will fight for us!**" **Nehemiah 4:19-20 (NLT)**
