# DID JESUS SAY THAT? Follow Your Heart

## **Jeremiah 17:9-10a (NLT)**

<sup>9</sup> "The human heart is the most deceitful of all things, and desperately wicked. Who really knows how bad it is?

<sup>10</sup> But I, the Lord, search all hearts and examine secret motives.

# Matthew 15:10-11 (NIV)

<sup>10</sup> Jesus called the crowd to him and said, "Listen and understand. <sup>11</sup> What goes into someone's mouth does not defile them, but what comes out of their mouth, that is what defiles them."

#### Matthew 15:16-20 (NIV)

16 "Are you still so dull?" Jesus asked them. 17 "Don't you see that whatever enters the mouth goes into the stomach and then out of the body? 18 But the things that come out of a person's mouth come from the heart, and these defile them. 19 For out of the heart come evil thoughts—murder, adultery, sexual immorality, theft, false testimony, slander. 20 These are what defile a person; but eating with unwashed hands does not defile them."

# Jeremiah 17:1a (NET)

<sup>1</sup> The sin of Judah is engraved with an iron chisel on their stone-hard hearts.

#### Proverbs 28:14 (NIV)

<sup>14</sup> Blessed is the one who always trembles before God, but **whoever hardens their heart** falls into trouble.

#### 1 Samuel 6:6a (NET)

<sup>6</sup> **Why harden your hearts** like the Egyptians and Pharaoh did?

#### Proverbs 4:23 (NIV)

<sup>23</sup> **Above all else**, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it.

Heart = the inner core of a person, the thoughts, feelings, desires, will, and choices that make that person who he/she is.

### Psalm 51:10-17 (NLT)

- <sup>10</sup> Create in me a clean heart, O God. Renew a loyal spirit within me. <sup>11</sup> Do not banish me from your presence, and don't take your Holy Spirit from me. <sup>12</sup> Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and make me willing to obey you.
- <sup>13</sup> **Then I will teach your ways** to rebels, and they will return to you. <sup>14</sup> **Forgive me** for shedding blood, O God who saves; then I will joyfully sing of your forgiveness. <sup>15</sup> Unseal my lips, O Lord, that my mouth may praise you.
- <sup>16</sup> You do not desire a sacrifice, or I would offer one. You do not want a burnt offering. <sup>17</sup> The sacrifice you desire is a broken spirit. You will not reject a broken and repentant heart. O God.

We shouldn't follow our hearts. We should condition our hearts to follow after God!

## **Ezekiel 36:26 (NIV)**

<sup>26</sup> I will give you a **new heart** and put a new spirit in you; I will remove from you **your heart of stone** and give you a **heart of flesh**.
