### DISCUSSION ABOUT THE VIDEO

- What stands out to you from today's video? (Read Luke 19:1-10)

- Zaccheus was an outcast who had been condemned by those in society. In what ways can you relate, or you felt like an outsider?
- Do you tend to struggle more with being judged, or judging others?
- How would you feel if you were in Zaccheus shoes and Jesus invited himself to your home? Excited? Nervous? Explain.
- On average, how often do you worry what others think of you? How well do you normally handle people wanting your approval?
- If you had a friend who told you she believed that Jesus only wanted to condemn her of her past mistakes... how would you respond? What specific Scriptures or stories would you base your response on?
- How can you share this truth about Jesus with others this week?

### DISCUSSION ABOUT THE VIDEO

- What stands out to you from today's video? (Read John 18:28-40)
- Have you ever been in a situation similar to Pilate's when you felt caught in the middle of other people's agendas? How did you handle it?
- Why do you think Jesus often responded to his captors with a question? Why did this method enrage the Jewish religious leaders?
- Why is it easier to see God's purpose for a situation AFTER the fact, or event?
- Why do you think Pilate placed such an emphasis on defining terms such as king or truth in his conversation with Jesus? What was he trying to determine?
- Think about what Jesus said and did during his trials before Annas, Caiaphas, Herod and Pilate. What can you learn from his example about dealing with those in power?
- How would you respond if a friend asked if you believed in “absolute truth”? And how would you use the Bible to support that answer? And what experiences do you have that support that as well?
